

Weatherization Rebates Application

Valid Jan. 1, 2026 - Dec. 31, 2026

Applications must be received within 30 days of installation or by December 31, 2026, whichever comes first. IMPORTANT NOTE: The maximum rebate per insulation and air sealing project is \$1,200. An additional \$400 is available for duct sealing.

Instructions for use

- Complete a qualifying weatherization project in a residential dwelling with an active service Classification 1 Peoples Gas or North Shore Gas account. Multi-Family properties with three or more living units should apply through the Custom Program.
- Review terms and conditions on page five of this application and have the customer sign the acceptance of terms on page two. Customer must also sign the Payment Release Authorization section on page two to indicate they understand the rebate will be deducted from the invoice and paid directly to the contractor.
- Submit this completed and signed application with the required supporting documents listed below:
 - A copy of the customer's most recent natural gas utility bill
 - A clear, legible copy of the invoice showing contractor name, installation date and address, customer name and total project cost, including labor
 - If also applying for attic and/or wall insulation, square footage, insulation type, and R-value of attic insulation pre- and post- installation must be included
 - Duct sealing projects must include pre- and post-duct leakage readings
 - All weatherization rebates will be made payable to the contractor in order to lower upfront costs for the customer; the invoice must show that the rebate was deducted from the total project cost and not charged to the customer
 - The supplemental air sealing worksheet completed by the contractor (required for air sealing projects only)
- Pre and post photos of insulation and air sealing projects.
- Important: Photocopy your entire submission to keep for your records.

Important specifications: Attic insulation projects are only valid when completed with air sealing. Installation must result in a final R-value of R49 or greater. If the attic contains vermiculite/perlite insulation, it is recommended that consultation with a properly trained and certified individual be completed before any insulation work is done. The total rebate for attic insulation is limited to \$500 per household.

Wall insulation

Up to \$400. Requires the completion of air sealing to qualify. Not valid as a standalone project.

Important specifications: Wall insulation projects are only valid when completed with air sealing. Wall insulation rebates are available for exterior walls, which includes kneewalls and sloped ceilings of finished attics, and above-grade foundation sidewalls, which includes band joist areas. Existing insulation R-value must be R5 or less. Installation must result in a final R-value of at least R13, or in compliance with local code, whichever is greater. The total rebate for wall insulation for any combination of the wall types above is limited to \$400 per household.

Duct sealing

Up to \$400. Valid as a standalone project.

Important specifications: For forced air natural gas furnace duct systems only. Unconditioned spaces include exterior and attic spaces. Semi-conditioned spaces are those unfinished spaces not directly heated. At a minimum, plenums, main ducts, takeoffs and boots must be sealed. In areas where mastic is the main source of sealing, thickness of mastic must be a minimum of 1/16 inch and a good faith effort must be made to remove existing duct tape and cover with mastic. Each gas account is eligible for one rebate up to \$400. Residences with more than one qualifying system are not eligible for multiple rebates. Pre and post CFM25 duct leakage measurements shall be conducted with a duct pressure test.

Air sealing

Up to \$400. Required with attic insulation projects, but also valid as a standalone project.

Important specifications: Pre- and post-CFM50 infiltration rate shall be determined by performing a blower door test in accordance with Building Performance Institute (BPI) standards. The post air sealing infiltration rate shall guarantee the home meets the minimum ventilation requirements of ASHRAE 62.2. The combustion safety of combustion appliances shall be verified by testing appliances per BPI standards to ensure they meet acceptable levels. All test results must be recorded on the air sealing worksheet. The total rebate for air sealing is limited to \$400 per household.

Terms and conditions

1. **Rebate offer:** Weatherization rebates are available through Peoples Gas and North Shore Gas to assist customers in making energy efficiency improvements. This program is available from January 1, 2026 to December 31, 2026 to eligible Peoples Gas and North Shore Gas customers ("Customers"). Weatherization rebate applications must be received within 30 days of installation date to be eligible and no later than December 31, 2026. Projects must result in reduced natural gas use due to improvements in energy efficiency. Reduced natural gas use resulting from fuel switching, power generation, renewable energy or operating schedule changes will not qualify.
2. **Eligibility:** Weatherization measures must be new and completed in a qualifying residential dwelling that is a customer of Peoples Gas or North Shore Gas and/or a delivery service customer in Illinois. The dwelling must use natural gas as the primary heating source to be eligible. In order to qualify, all weatherization measures must be installed by contractors on the approved contractor lists. Your eligibility for this offer is subject to approval by our designated program administrator.
3. **Compliance:**
 - a. All projects must comply with the applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations, including building codes.
 - b. Weatherization projects must be installed in an existing building.
 - c. Not available for new construction, building additions or major renovations.
 - d. Only one rebate will be granted for each project.
4. **Delivery:** Applications must be delivered one of two ways:

5. **Applications:** Submissions must have complete information and include:
 - a. The entire completed application signed by the Customer.
 - b. A copy of the Customer's most recent natural gas utility bill.
 - c. A clear, legible copy of the invoice showing contractor name, installation date and address, Customer name and total project cost including labor.
 - i. Air sealing projects must include pre- and post-blower door readings
 - ii. If also applying for attic and/or additional insulation, square footage, insulation type and R-value of attic insulation pre- and post- installation must be included
 - iii. Duct sealing projects must include pre- and post-duct leakage readings
 - iv. All weatherization rebates will be made payable to the contractor in order to lower upfront costs for the Customer; the invoice must show that the rebate was deducted from the total project's cost and not charged to the Customer
6. **Payment:** Once completed paperwork is submitted, rebate payments are usually made within 6-8 weeks. Incomplete applications will either delay payments or result in denial of the application. Peoples Gas and/or North Shore Gas reserve the right to refuse payment and participation if the Customer or contractor violates program terms and conditions.
7. **Inspection:** Program staff reserves the right to conduct on-site pre- and post-inspections of proposed and installed projects.
8. **Tax information:** Rebates may be subject to federal and/or state income tax reporting. Applicant is responsible for contacting a qualified tax advisor to determine tax liability. Peoples Gas and/or North Shore Gas are not responsible for any tax liability imposed on the Customer or contractor as a result of the payment of rebates.
9. **Publicity:** Peoples Gas and/or North Shore Gas reserve the right to publicize participation in this program, unless you specifically request otherwise in writing.
10. **Program discretion:** Rebates are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Rebate amounts and offerings are subject to change or termination without notice at the discretion of Peoples Gas and/or North Shore Gas.
11. **Logo use:** Customers or contractors may not use the Peoples Gas or North Shore Gas company and program names or logos in any marketing, advertising or promotional material without written permission.
